## **A Thriving Program**

The Prison Pup Program is a thriving program that began with 3 inmate puppy raisers in 2002 and today has expanded to 24 puppy raisers.

The program is a partnership between Saint Francis Service Dogs and The Virginia Department of Corrections at Bland Correctional Center, a medium-security prison that holds approximately 650 male offenders.

In addition to helping Saint Francis Service Dogs and the people we serve, the program has extraordinary benefits to the inmates and the prison as well as the broader community.

- Increased moral
- Acquired relational & vocational skills
- Improved rehabilitation
- Decrease in stress, isolation and fear
- Reduced rate of recidivism

With more than 170 people with disabilities waiting for a Saint Francis Service Dog, we have a critical need to raise and train more puppies. We can come closer to meeting that need with our Prison Pup Program.



#### What we need

It takes approximately \$60,000 to operate our Prison Pup Program each year.

Staff	\$45,000
Supplies	\$7,000
Vet Care	\$2,000
Vehicle/Travel	\$1,000
Admin/Overhead (10%)	\$5,400

#### Our Goal: \$300,000
